

Dear Friend,

As we are all well aware by now, we are currently in the midst of a heat wave. And the prolonged hot and dry spell is constantly drawing out comparisons with the well remembered summer of 1976. Personally, I don't remember that summer, but my parents have photographs of me in my pushchair in the bow of a narrow boat as we holidayed on the canals. They also have photographs of cows that have come down from the fields into the canals to get water.

In times like this we notice our need for water more than usual. We naturally thirst more, and we crave the refreshment and sustenance that a nice cold glass of water can bring us.

Yet we also recognise that such nice, cold, refreshing water only assuages our thirst for a short time. We know that we will thirst again and that we will need to drink again and again in order to keep our bodies healthy.

But we also recognise that we thirst in other ways too. We thirst for love; we thirst for pleasure; we thirst for friendship; we thirst for recognition; we thirst for things. The list goes on and on.
